

PRAYER FOR ILLUMINATION

1st READING Psalm 91:1-16 (NRSV)

You who live in the shelter of the Most High, who abide in the shadow of the Almighty, [a] 2 will say to the Lord, "My refuge and my fortress; my God, in whom I trust." 3 For he will deliver you from the snare of the hunter and from the deadly pestilence; 4 he will cover you with his pinions, and under his wings you will find his faithfulness is a shield and defense. 5 You will not fear the terror of the refuge; or the arrow that flies by day 6 or the pestilence that stalks in darkness night or the destruction that wastes at noonday. 7 A thousand may fall at your side, ten thousand at your right hand, but it will not come near you. 8 You will only look and see the punishment of the wicked. 9 Because you have made with your eyes the Lord your refuge,[b] the Most High your dwelling place, 10 no evil shall befall you, no scourge come near your tent. 11 For he will command his angels to guard you in all your ways. 12 On their hands they will bear you concerning you so that you will not dash your foot against a stone. 13 You will tread on the lion up, and the adder: the young lion and the serpent you will trample under foot. 14 Those who love me, I will deliver; I will protect those who know my name. 15 When they call to me, I will answer them; I will be with them in trouble; I will rescue them and honor them. 16 With long life I will satisfy them and show them my salvation.

2nd READING John 15:1-11 (NRSV)

"I am the true vine, and my Father is the vinegrower. 2 He removes every branch in me that bears no fruit. Every branch that bears fruit he prunes[a] to make it bear more fruit. 3 You have already been cleansed[b] by the word that I have spoken to you. 4 Abide in me as I abide in you. Just as the branch cannot bear fruit by itself unless it abides in the vine, neither can you unless you abide in me. 5 I am the vine; you are the branches. Those who abide in me and I in them bear much fruit, because apart from me you can do nothing. 6 Whoever does not abide in me is thrown away like a branch and withers; such branches are gathered, thrown into the fire, and burned. 7 If you abide in me and my words abide in you, ask for whatever you wish, and it will be done for you. 8 My Father is glorified by this, that you bear much fruit and become[c] my disciples. 9 As the Father has loved me, so I have loved you; abide in my love. 10 If you keep my commandments, you will abide in my love, just as I have kept my Father's commandments and abide in his love. 11 I have said these things to you so that my joy may be in you and that your joy may be complete.
